AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEWISVILLE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE LEWISVILLE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 15, SECTION 15-62, PEDESTRIAN CROSSING RESTRICTED, BY ADDING A PROHIBITION FOR PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ON VALLEY PARKWAY FROM 50 FEET SOUTH OF MAIN STREET TO 50 FEET NORTH OF KATHY LANE EXCEPT AT THE DESIGNATED PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK; PROVIDING A PENALTY, REPEALER AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lewisville has determined that for the health, welfare and safety of its citizens, and upon engineering and traffic investigations conducted by the State of Texas or the City of Lewisville, an amendment to the Lewisville City Code, chapter 15 is necessary to prohibit pedestrian crossing on Valley Parkway from 50 feet south of Main Street to 50 feet north of Kathy Lane except at the designated pedestrian crosswalk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Lewisville City Code, chapter 15, Traffic and Vehicles, article III, section 15-62, Pedestrian crossing restricted, is hereby amended by adding the following street entry:

<i>Street or Intersection</i>	<i>Extent</i>
Valley Parkway	50 feet south of Main Street to 50 feet north of Kathy Lane except at the designated pedestrian crossing.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. Every ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect.

SECTION 4. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof in the municipal court, shall be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred (\$500.00) for each offense.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It being for the public welfare that this ordinance be passed creates an emergency and public necessity and the rule requiring this ordinance be read on three separate occasions be, and the same is hereby, waived and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication, as the law in such cases provides.
