**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, APPOINTING A  
PRIMARY REPRESENTATIVE TO THE REGIONAL  
TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL TO REPLACE  
COUNCILMEMBER BRANDON JONES AND  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Regional Transportation Council (RTC), composed primarily of local elected officials, is the transportation policy body for the MPO; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bylaws state that the person representing a group of several cities shall be selected by the mayors using a weighted vote of the maximum population or employment of the cities represented, and the person selected shall serve a two-year term beginning in July of even-numbered years and shall be serving on one of the governing bodies they represent; and

**WHEREAS**, the cities of Lewisville, Highland Village, and Justin and the Towns of Flower Mound and Northlake share a seat on the RTC; and

**WHEREAS**, the current primary representative on the RTC is Councilmember Brandon Jones; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Jones did not run for re-election and thus shall no longer serve on the Lewisville City Council upon the election of his successor; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it to be in the public interest to replace Councilmember Jones as the primary representative on the RTC. and to appoint a new primary representative on the RTC.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City of Lewisville hereby appoints \_\_\_\_\_, as the primary representative on the Regional Transportation Council.

**SECTION 2.** That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
