SUBJECT: **Approval of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lewisville, Texas, Reappointing Mayor TJ Gilmore as Primary Representative to the Regional Transportation Council and Providing for an Effective Date.**

BACKGROUND

The City currently holds a seat on the North Central Texas Council of Governments Regional Transportation Council (RTC). The RTC is the independent transportation policy body of the Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Membership on the Regional Transportation Council is either by direct membership or group representation. The Cities of Lewisville, Highland Village, Justin, and the Towns of Flower Mound and North Lake share a seat on the council.

The primary activities when serving on the RTC include: guiding the development of multimodal transportation plans and programs; determining the allocation of federal, state and regional transportation funds; selecting transportation projects in some programs and recommending projects to the Texas Transportation Commission for other programs; ensuring transportation providers coordinate services; and, ensuring the metropolitan area complies with state and federal laws and regulations regarding transportation and air quality.

Membership on the RTC requires a significant time commitment, including attendance at monthly meetings and reports.

ANALYSIS

The appointee is required to be an elected official who serves on the governing body they represent. The current City appointee to this position is Mayor TJ Gilmore, who was appointed in 2025. Mayor Gilmore desires to continue to serve in this capacity.

CITY STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council approve the resolution reappointing Mayor TJ Gilmore as primary representative to the Regional Transportation Council as set forth in the caption above.
