A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2025 STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT AWARD, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) is administered by the Texas Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grants Division, with funding from the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Administration, an agency of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and

WHEREAS, the SLCGP supports cybersecurity efforts to address imminent cybersecurity threats to local information; and

WHEREAS, the SLCGP requires the City to provide a 10% cash match as part of the grant award; and

WHEREAS, the SLCGP awarded the City a \$39,201.74 grant for the City's Network Access Control Software project, to be administered during the project period November 1, 2024, through August 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved a resolution on January 27, 2025, accepting the grant award; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas has mandated that the City designate an authorized official for all state and federal grants;

WHEREAS, in the original resolution, the designation of the authorized official was inadvertently omitted, necessitating this amendment;

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville wishes to designate the the City's Chief Information Officer as the City's authorized official for the purpose of this grant award, with the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant and to certify changes made to the grant application or grant on behalf of the City;

WHEREAS, this resolution shall supersede any previous resolutions or parts thereof pertaining to the City's acceptance of the 2025 SLCGP grant award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lewisville, Texas, accepts the 2025 SLCGP grant award for the City's Network Access Control Software project in the amount of \$39,201.74.

SECTION 2. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

SECTION 3. The City Council designates the City's Chief Information Officer as the authorized official for the purpose of this grant award, with authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate this grant, and to certify changes made to the grant application or grant on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
