3. Public Hearing: Public Hearing: Consideration of an Ordinance Granting a Zone Change From Light Industrial (LI) District to Planned Development - Multi-Family Three (PD-MF-3) District, on 7.082 Acres out of the S.M. Hayden Survey, Abstract No. 537A and Hurst Industrial Park Addition Block A, Lot 1; Located at 1918 and 1926-1954 East State Highway 121 Business; as Requested by ZoneDev, the Applicant, on Behalf of Hairadin Investment Group Inc. and Joey & Daphne D Hurst, the Property Owners. (26-04-3-PZ)

Jon Beckham, Senior Planner, gave a brief overview of the zone change request and staff's recommendation. Maxwell Fischer with ZoneDev, the applicant, gave a presentation. Commissioner Jack Tidwell asked if there were any environmental remediation issues with the site. Spence Miller stated no and that none are expected. There were no other questions. Vice Chair Ali opened the public hearing. With no one indicating a desire to speak, the public hearing was then closed. A motion was made by Joshua Peterson to recommend approval of the zone change as presented, seconded by Francisca Al-waely. The motion passed unanimously (6-0). Richard E. Luedke, Planning Director, stated that the second public hearing for this case will not be scheduled until staff receives an authorization letter from the owner authorizing the applicant to move forward onto the city council meeting.
