**WHEREAS**, rising isolation and loneliness undermine physical and mental health, reduce life expectancy, weaken social cohesion, and diminish overall well-being; and

**WHEREAS**, strong neighbor relationships enhance health, resilience, civic engagement, crime prevention, disaster response, and ultimately create safer, healthier, and more inclusive communities; and

**WHEREAS**, to support the Big Move "Diverse and Thriving Neighborhoods," the City empowers residents through grants and programs such as the Neighborhood Enhancement Program, Love Your Block mini-grant, and Rock the Block Trailer.
