

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE REMNANT DEFENDANTS OPIOID SETTLEMENT WITH ASSOCIATED PHARMACIES, INC AND AMERICAN ASSOCIATED PHARMACIES, J M SMITH CORPORATION, LOUISIANA WHOLESALE DRUG COMPANY, INC., MORRIS AND DICKSON CO., NORTH CAROLINA MUTUAL WHOLESALE DRUG COMPANY, INC., AND UNITED NATURAL FOODS, INC., INCLUDING ITS SUBSIDIARIES SUPERVALU AND ADVANTAGE LOGISTICS, AND THEIR ASSOCIATED ENTITIES; AND APPROVING THE SIX (6) REMNANT DEFENDANTS' COMBINED SUBDIVISION PARTICIPATION AND RELEASE FORM REGARDING THE SAME; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ABOVE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City obtained information indicating that regional opioid distributors/dispensers Remnant Defendants Opioid Settlement with Associated Pharmacies, Inc and American Associated Pharmacies, J M Smith Corporation, Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., Morris and Dickson Co., North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., and United Natural Foods, Inc., including its subsidiaries SuperValu and Advantage Logistics, and their associated entities (the “Remnant Defendants”) have engaged in fraudulent and/or reckless distribution of opioids that has resulted in addictions and overdoses; and

WHEREAS, these actions, conduct and misconduct have resulted in significant financial costs to the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed combined settlement agreement with the Remnant Defendants will provide a one-time cash payment to participating political subdivisions (the “Settlement Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Settlement Agreement, the City must approve the Six (6) Remnant Defendants’ Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form associated with the Settlement Agreement, which requires the City to release certain claims against the Remnant Defendants as consideration for participation in the Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Lewisville to participate in the Settlement Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is a substantial need for repayment of opioid-related expenditures and payment to abate opioid-related harms in and about the City of Lewisville.

SECTION 2. The Lewisville City Council agrees to the terms outlined in and approves the Remnant Defendants’ Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form associated with the Settlement Agreement, and authorizes the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Lewisville, to execute all necessary documents in connection with the Settlement Agreement, including the Six (6) Remnant Defendants’ Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form associated with the Settlement Agreement, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 3. The City Council understands that the allocation of direct payment funds through the Settlement Agreement is set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
