WHEREAS, the State of Texas (the "State") owns and maintains a system of highways and roadways within the boundaries of the City of Lewisville (the "City"); and;

WHEREAS, the City desires that equipment on these highways and roadways be compatible with standard signal operation or existing City equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested the State to reimburse the cost of furnishing traffic signal equipment at the intersection of IH35E at Corporate Dr. (CSJ: 0196-02-126), IH35E at BUS 121 (CSJ: 0196-02-127), and BUS 121 at Mill St. (CSJ: 0364-03-101) (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2018, the Texas Transportation Commission passed Minute Order No. 115291, approving the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and the State for the City to assist the State by furnishing traffic signal equipment on the Project; and

WHEREAS, the State, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City for the Project pursuant to Texas Transportation Code §221.002; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Agreement for the Furnishing of Traffic Signal Equipment by a Municipality with the State for the purpose of reimbursing the City for the costs of furnishing traffic signal equipment for the Project; and
