



Proclamation

BY THE

City Council of the City of Lewisville

WHEREAS, there are more than 1,280,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Lewisville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, since 1786, over 24,000 U.S. law enforcement officers have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty, with their names honored on the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, in 2025, 363 names of fallen Peace Officers are being added to the National Memorial—109 from 2025 and 254 from prior years. Texas was one of the highest in the nation in 2025 line-of-duty deaths with 8 Peace Officers lost; and

WHEREAS, May 15 is designated as Peace Officers Memorial Day, in honor of all fallen officers and their families and U.S. flags should be flown at half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TJ Gilmore, Mayor of the City of Lewisville, Texas and on behalf of the City Council, do hereby proclaim the week of May 11-17, 2026, as:

NATIONAL POLICE WEEK

and May 15, 2026, as:

PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL DAY

in the City of Lewisville and urge all residents to make every effort to express heartfelt appreciation to the men and women who have dedicated their lives to preserving peace and safety in our community.
