Item A: Call to Order and Announce that a Quorum is Present

With a quorum present, the Lewisville Planning and Zoning Commission meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Erum Ali at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2024, in the Council Chambers, of the Lewisville City Hall, 151 West Church Street, Lewisville, Texas.

Item B1: Approval of Minutes

Consider the minutes from the September 17, 2024, regular meeting. A motion was made by Jack Tidwell to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Joshua Peterson. The motion passed unanimously (5-0).

Item C: Public Hearing

2. Public Hearing: Consideration of a Special Use Permit for Automotive Repair (Minor); on Approximately 1.5871-Acres Tract, Legally Described as Lot 9, Block A, Fairway Business Park; Located at 1504 Eagle Court, Zoned Light Industrial District (LI); as Requested by Texas Star Automotive Services, on Behalf of AIP Eagle Court, LLC, the Property Owner. (Case No. 24-08-15-SUP)

Jon Beckham, Senior Planner, gave a brief overview and staff's recommendation. Lewellen asked about overnight customer vehicles. Staff stated that any vehicle kept overnight would need to be stored inside the building. The Vice Chair Ali opened the public hearing. With no one indicating a desire to speak, the public hearing was then closed. There was no discussion. A motion was made by Rick Lewellen to recommend approval of the special use permit as presented, seconded by Ainsley Stelling. The motion passed unanimously (5-0). Richard E Luedke, Planning Director, stated that the item would appear before the City Council on November 4, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. for a second public hearing and a final decision.

Further stated that the planning staff gathered input for the Old Town Master Plan update. The regular Planning and Zoning Commission meeting will follow and start at 7:00 p.m.
