

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEWISVILLE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE LEWISVILLE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 15, SECTION 15-36, MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS NEAR SCHOOLS, BY REPEALING THE SCHOOL SPEED ZONES ON COWAN AVENUE FROM 300 FEET SOUTH OF MILL STREET TO 400 FEET NORTH OF MILL STREET, ON MILL STREET FROM 600 FEET SOUTH OF VALLEY RIDGE BOULEVARD TO 400 FEET NORTH OF VALLEY RIDGE BOULEVARD, AND ON VALLEY RIDGE BOULEVARD FROM 400 FEET WEST OF MILL STREET TO MILL STREET; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND A PENALTY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lewisville, Texas, has determined that for the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens, amending Chapter 15, Sections 15-36 of the Lewisville City Code is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Lewisville City Code, Chapter 15, Traffic and Vehicles, Article II, Speed Limits, Section 15-36 is hereby amended by deleting the following:

<i>Street/Highway</i>	<i>Designated School Zone</i>
Cowan Avenue	From 300 feet south of Mill Street to 400 feet north of Mill Street
Mill Street	From 600 feet south of Valley Ridge Boulevard to 400 feet north of Valley Ridge Boulevard
Valley Ridge Boulevard	From 400 feet west of Mill Street to Mill Street (F.M. 3504)

SECTION 2. REPEALER. Every ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect.

SECTION 4. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of Lewisville, Texas, shall be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It being for the public welfare that this ordinance be passed creates an emergency and public necessity, and the rule requiring this ordinance be read on three separate occasions be, and the same is hereby waived, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication, as the law in such cases provides.
