A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE DENTON RECORD-CHRONICLE AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DENTON PUBLIC MEDIA, LLC, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 52.004 of Chapter 52 of the Local Government Code, provides that the City Council of a home-rule city shall, as soon as practicable after the commencement of each municipal year, contract with a public newspaper as the official paper thereof, same to continue as such until another is elected; and

WHEREAS, Denton Public Media, LLC has submitted the best bid for the official newspaper and complies with the requirements of Section 2051.044 of the Texas Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lewisville hereby designates, pursuant to Section 2051.044 of the Texas Government Code, and Section 52.004 of Chapter 52 of the Local Government Code, the Denton Record-Chronicle, a public newspaper in and of Denton County, Texas, as the official paper of said city, same to continue as such until another is elected, and shall cause to be published therein all ordinances, notices, and other matters required by law or by the ordinances to be published or by the Charter of said city.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to contract with Denton Public Media, LLC for said Denton Record-Chronicle newspaper to become the official newspaper

of the city and to do any and all acts necessary and appropriate in furtherance of this resolution and to effectuate said contract.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
