**WHEREAS**, the Police Records staff responds to requests from internal and external customers and is integral in building relationships with other police agencies, governmental entities, and other organizations promoting interagency communication; and

*WHEREAS*, the Lewisville Police Department creates approximately 12,000 offense records and approximately 4,600 arrest records each year, which must be coded and maintained; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Records staff play a significant role in properly disseminating public records under the Public Information Act, and the City of Lewisville recognizes the importance of every law enforcement position in service to our community.
