A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY **OF** LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, **AUTHORIZING** PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF TEXAS, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, IN THE ALVOGEN, INC., APOTEX CORP., AMNEAL PHARMACEUTICALS LLC, KIMA PHARMACEUTICALS USA INC., INDIVIOR INC., VIATRIS INC. ("MYLAN"), SUN PHARMACEUTICAL INDUSTRIES, INC., AND ZYDUS **PHARMACEUTICALS** INC. (USA) **OPIOID** SETTLEMENTS AND APPROVING THE SECONDARY **MANUFACTURERS' COMBINED SUBDIVISION** PARTICIPATION AND RELEASE FORM REGARDING THE SAME; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ABOVE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; **AND** PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City obtained information indicating that generic opioid manufacturers Alvogen, Inc., Apotex Corp., Amneal Pharmaceuticals LLC, Kima Pharmaceuticals USA Inc., Indivior Inc., Viatris Inc. ("Mylan"), Sun Pharmaceutical Industries, Inc., and Zydus Pharmaceuticals (USA) Inc., and their associated entities ("Defendants") have engaged in fraudulent and/or reckless manufacturing, promotion, and distribution of opioids that has resulted in addictions and overdoses; and

WHEREAS, these actions, conduct and misconduct have resulted in significant financial costs to the City; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2021, the Lewisville City Council adopted and approved the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council and Settlement Allocation Term Sheet (the "Texas Term Sheet") approving the allocation of any and all opioid settlement funds within the State of Texas, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas, through the Office of the Attorney General, has entered into settlement agreements with the Defendants, which includes Texas political subdivisions and which will provide funding and injunctive relief (the "Settlement Agreements"); and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Settlement Agreements, the City must approve the Secondary Manufacturers' Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form associated with the Settlement Agreements, which requires the City to release certain claims against the Defendants as consideration for participation in the Settlement Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Lewisville to participate in the Settlement Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is a substantial need for repayment of opioid-related expenditures and payment to abate opioid-related harms in and about the City of Lewisville.

SECTION 2. The Lewisville City Council agrees to the terms outlined in and approves the Secondary Manufacturers' Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form associated with the Settlement Agreements, and authorizes the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Lewisville, to execute all necessary documents in connection with the Settlement Agreements, including the Secondary Manufacturers' Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form associated with the Settlement Agreements, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

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SECTION 3. The City Council understand	ds that the allocation of direct payment funds
and other funds made available through the Settlem	ent Agreements is set forth in the Texas Term
Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit A .	
SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effe	ect immediately upon adoption.
