A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF THE JUVENILE CURFEW ORDINANCE, CURRENTLY SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE II, OF THE LEWISVILLE CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville adopted an ordinance on September 12, 1994, providing a curfew for minors within the corporate limits of the City of Lewisville; and

WHEREAS, after review and public hearings, the City of Lewisville has continued said curfew for minors pursuant to Section 370.002 of the Texas Local Government Code every three years since its adoption; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville has again reviewed the curfew ordinance and its effects on the community and the problems said ordinance was intended to remedy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lewisville has conducted two public hearings, in accordance with Section 370.002 of the Local Government Code, to determine if the curfew ordinance is still necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lewisville is of the opinion that the curfew ordinance is still necessary, and thus its continuation will be beneficial to the welfare and safety of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS:
