**SUBJECT: Consideration of an Appointment to the Denton County Workforce Success Leadership Team.**

### **BACKGROUND**

In 2019, the United Way of Denton County invited the City of Lewisville to appoint a representative, preferably a City Council member, to serve on the newly formed Denton County Workforce Success Leadership Team. The team's mission is to improve financial stability and increase earning potential for low-to-moderate-income working families throughout Denton County.

Through initiatives such as ALICE and Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA), the Denton County Workforce Success Leadership Team connects residents with resources that help address financial challenges, provide free tax preparation services, and support long-term financial stability and economic opportunity.

### **ANALYSIS**

Former council member Bob Troyer was appointed to the team in 2019, and served in this role until his resignation from the City Council in May 2026. City Council is being asked to appoint a new representative to fill this vacancy.
