SUBJECT: Approval of a Resolution Authorizing a Multiple Use Agreement Between the

City of Lewisville, and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Authorizing Flock Safety to Install Automated License Plate Readers Along TxDOT Rights-of-Way on the Highway Right-of-Way of FM 407 Roadway.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Lewisville Police Department routinely uses this Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system throughout the City of Lewisville. This request is to expand the system by adding an additional ALPR camera on FM407 and Lake Park Road. Because this location is within State right-of-way, TxDOT approval is required. The Primary purpose of the ALPR system is to assist in the detection and apprehension of vehicles and/or persons traveling through the jurisdiction of the Lewisville Police Department in a vehicle that has license plates that have been entered into the National Crime Index Computer or on the LPD ALPR Hotlist.

## **ANALYSIS**

This agreement would be advantageous and beneficial to the residents of Lewisville by assisting the Lewisville Police Department in locating, apprehending, and removing criminals off of the streets of Lewisville. The ALPR system can also be utilized by LPD detectives to assist in the development of leads that can eventually identify suspects who have committed crimes in Lewisville.
