**Whereas**, targets of bullying are more likely to acquire physical, emotional, and learning problems and students who are repeatedly bullied often fear such activities as riding the bus, going to school, and attending community activities; and

**Whereas**, children who witness bullying often feel less secure, more fearful, and intimated.

**Pow, Therefore,** I, Rudy Durham, Mayor of the City of Lewisville, Texas, and on behalf of the Lewisville City Council, do hereby proclaim the week of October 1 - 8, 2018, as:

## "Say No to Bullying Week"
