A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS TO PROVIDE HOMEBUYER EDUCATION CLASSES TO LEWISVILLE RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, authorizes governmental entities to contract with each other to perform government functions and services under the terms thereof; and

WHEREAS, Plano and Lewisville are political subdivisions within the State of Texas and are all engaged in the provision of governmental services for the benefit of their citizens; and

WHEREAS, both cities desire to enter into an interlocal agreement for the purpose of providing joint homebuyer education classes; and

WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement sets forth obligations of each party including sharing costs and providing for referral of residents to the classes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the attached interlocal agreement between the City of Lewisville and the City of Plano to provide homebuyer education classes to Lewisville residents (Exhibit A).
