The CDBG Advisory Committee will consider the AAP on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall. Comments received during this period will be considered before final approval at another public hearing to be held by City Council on Monday, August 5, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall.

2019 Action Plan Summary

Lewisville will receive \$725,927 in CDBG funding and will add an estimated \$170,000 in City Social Service Agency funding for a total Grants Budget of \$895,927. The plan also uses approximately \$27,000 in program income.

CDBG social services funding: Children's Advocacy Center \$20,000, Court Appointed Special Advocates \$14,000, Denton County Friends of the Family \$10,000, PediPlace \$39,889, SPAN \$25,000.

City Social Service Funding: Boys & Girls Club \$5,000, Camp Summit \$5,000, Communities in Schools \$31,000, Friends of the Family \$6,750, Denton County MHMR \$8,750, Giving Hope \$8,000, Health Services of North Texas \$22,000, Journey to Dream \$10,000, New Hope Learning Center \$11,625, PediPlace \$20,111, Retired Senior Volunteer Program \$10,500, Salvation Army \$5,000, Special Abilities of North Texas \$5,000, Youth and Family Counseling \$12,764. Considered but not funded: TruCare Clinic. Withdrawn: Chin Refugee Ministries.

Housing and Community Development Projects: \$498,853 will be used for Park Development and Accessibility in or around the area between I-35, Corporate Dr., and Highway 121.

Administration: \$145,185.
