Consideration of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 6, Land Development Regulations, of the Lewisville City Code, by Amending Section 6-123, Multi-Family and Non-Residential Landscaping Requirements, to Increase the Required Landscape Strip and Allow for Reductions of the Strip in Certain Circumstances; Providing for a Repealer, Severability, a Penalty, and an Effective Date; and Declaring an Emergency.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENTS:**

These amendments are proposed to increase the landscaping requirements, furthering the Big Move Number 2: Extending the Green, Big Move Number 4: Thriving Neighborhoods, and Big Move Number 9: Sustainability of the Lewisville 2025 Plan. The provisions also permit a reduction in the landscape buffer to it's existing standard provided other community character standards are met. This provision will reduce complications associated with redevelopment but also apply to new developments.
